**Russell City Council Meeting – Continuation of March 17, 2020 meeting

**Executive Session**

Councilmember Cross made a motion for City council to recess into executive session, to include the City Manager, Assistant City Manager, and City Attorney, to discuss individual employees pursuant to the non-elected personnel matter exception, KSA 75-4319(b)(1). **1. Resolution 05-20 Temporary Regulations to Mitigate COVID-19 Spread**

Councilmember Cross made a motion to adopt the resolution providing temporary regulations to mitigate the COVID-19 spread. Councilmember Stoppel seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

**2. Closure of City Facilities**

Councilmember Madden made a motion that effective immediately and until further notice, City of Russell facilities be closed to the public except for the Russell Municipal Airport, public transit bus, public parks and Russell Municipal Golf Course with no more than 10 people in the club house. Councilmember Morril seconded. The motion carried unanimously.
